- b. Write a small paragraph describing the importance of family and how each member plays a special role.

- a. What are the different types of landforms? Give examples.
- b. Name and explain the three major seasons in India.
- c. What is the difference between weather and climate?
- d. Who is the current President of India, and what are his/her duties?
- e. Write about one famous freedom fighter and their contribution to India's independence.

Part 3: Map Work

1. Draw the map of India and mark the following on it:
 - a. The seven continents (colour them differently).
 - b. The 10 major states of India.
 - c. The Himalayas.
 - d. The Arabian Sea, Bay of Bengal, and Indian Ocean.
2. Label the following rivers on the map:
 - a. Ganga
 - b. Yamuna
 - c. Narmada
 - d. Godavari

1. Nature Walk & Observation

Take a walk in your neighbourhood, park, or garden. Write a small note on what plants and animals you saw during your walk. How does nature help us in our daily life?

2. Make a Collage of Historical Monuments

Collect pictures of famous historical monuments of India (like the Taj Mahal, Qutub Minar, Red Fort, etc.) and create a collage. Write a few lines about each monument.
